

Collaboration Agreement

Between

University of Nairobi

And

Ahmedabad University, India

This Collaboration Agreement (**Collaboration**) is drawn up and agreed upon to establish the initial framework for cooperation between **University of Nairobi (hereinafter called UoN)** situated at Nairobi City County and **Ahmedabad University**.

This Collaboration is entered into on the 14th February 2020 by and between University of Nairobi of P.O. Box 30197 Nairobi,

And

Ahmedabad University.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as *party* and collectively as *parties*.

1: Scope

The initially proposed activities within the scope of the current Collaboration are:

- a) Activities leading to development of joint projects related to:
 - Faculty & Staff Development Program
 - Developing Short Term / Long Term Certificate Courses,
 - Working on collaborative research and consultancy projects,
 - Allowing students of Gujarat University for internship with UoN Faculty (students selection will be based on certain parameters determined by selection committee, which is designed by Ahmedabad University / UoN),
 - Working together on various Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) activities,

- Working together on entrepreneurship development and incubation centres
 - Co-supervision of postgraduate students and Joint degrees.
- b) Defining new areas of collaboration that have not been foreseen but can be beneficial to both the Parties.

2: Duration, Termination and Amendment

- a) The Collaboration will be effective from the date of signing by both parties for a period of up to five (5) years and may be subject to extension by mutual consent of the Parties, expressed in writing.
- b) Either party may terminate this Collaboration by giving six (6) months' notice in writing to the other Party.
- c) The provisions of the Collaboration may be amended at any time with the mutual consent of the Parties in writing.
- d) The amendment, termination and expiration of this Collaboration will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination and expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the Parties.
- e) No action undertaken shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will either party impose any constraints upon the other in carrying out the agreement.

3: Special Provisions

- a) Each Party will consult with, and take approval of, the other Party to use the latter's name, the names of the latter's officials / faculty members, and logo for the activities under this Collaboration, and dissemination of results, on a case by case basis.

- b) Detailed modalities of individual forms of collaboration, activities associated with them and financial aspects of each shall be mutually agreed upon on a case by case basis, and specified, with all necessary details, in separate Agreements.
- c) This Collaboration will not be legally & financially binding to any of the Parties. The two Parties will consult with each other and attempt to resolve disputes if any, that arise in the administration of this Collaboration or any subsequent associated Agreement informally.

4: Coordinators



Both Parties will designate persons who will have responsibility for coordination and implementation of this agreement.

5: Intellectual Property Rights

The intellectual property rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two parties .

6: Signed in Duplicate

This COLLABORATION is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity. By signing below, the *parties*, acting by their duly authorized officers, have caused this collaboration to be executed, effective as of the day and year first above written.
