MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Between

AHMEDABAD UNIVERSITY (Gujarat, India)

And

THE UNIVERSITY OF BRADFORD (Bradford, UK)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter MoU) is drawn up to provide a basis on which Ahmedabad University (hereafter AU) and the University of Bradford, UK (hereafter UoB) may establish a formal relationship specifically designed to promote collaboration and cultural co-operation between India and the UK. The MoU seeks to develop and strengthen the bonds between the two academic communities and in the process also contribute to generate understanding, cooperation and communication between the two cultures.

This MoU is intended to provide a basis on which formal agreements may be drawn up between the two parties in accordance with and under the terms of Quality Assurance arrangements of both parties to regulate the academic, financial, administrative, practical and other arrangements for the following proposed areas:-

- · Academic and research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest
- Exchange of academic information, scholarly information, materials and publications
- · Exchange of students and faculty
- Capacity building and knowledge transfer projects
- Sponsorship of cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings

The cooperation in any specific area will be subject to availability of funds and mutual agreement by the Universities. The intention is that a formal agreement will be produced and signed by both AU and UoB after deliberation and approval by the appropriate and competent authorities of both parties.

This MOU will be implemented in good faith. It expresses the hope and intention of the undersigning institutions to develop cooperation based on mutual respect. The MoU will be effective for an initial period of five years from the date of the signatures. This MoU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both parties. The agreement may be terminated by either University giving at least six months written notice to the other.
