## Background

Atlases are an important tool in gathering information about how species are distributed around us. This often requires large amounts of data and effort. Such data collection is therefore possible with the involvement from citizens who are passionate about collecting information both for documentation and in the intention of biodiversity conservation. Birds are one such taxa that are familiar to many and are easy to identify and document. Through citizen science projects, we can gather geographically vast extents of data on bird presences, absences as well as their abundances.

One of the first bird atlases covered the breeding biology of birds in Europe and ever since many countries have followed to document their own. India has also been successful in initiating such community-based research, with the *Mysore city bird atlas* (2014) and the *Kerala bird atlas* (2015). Following the idea and protocol behind them, many other Indian cities including Ahmedabad have initiated bird atlas projects.

The Ahmedabad City Bird Atlas is a collaborative effort between Bird Conservation Society Gujarat (BCSG) and the Community Ecology and Conservation Biology lab (CoCo) at Ahmedabad University, with the help and support of Bird Count India and eBird India. The Ahmedabad bird atlas is one of the first of its kind mapping out the birds in the urban landscape in western India. This project involved bird surveys from two seasons: 2024 winter and 2025 summer and many willing volunteers who spent their days searching for birds in the city. This report compiles the findings from the first season i.e. 2024 winter.

Methods




Figure 2. Randomly selected sub cells (yellow) of 1.2km<sup>2</sup> within each grid cell

The city of Ahmedabad measuring around 440 km<sup>2</sup> was divided into 61 grids of 9 km<sup>2</sup> (3.3 x 3.3 km) (Fig 1). These grid cells were further divided into nine sub cells of 1.2 km<sup>2</sup> (1.1 x 1.1 km). For a standardized survey, three of these cells (33% of each grid cell) were randomly selected for the survey (Fig 2).

All volunteers were briefed about the survey method by the field coordinator and team coordinators who were responsible in organizing this survey. To conduct the survey each volunteer team had to enter the bird checklist data and submit it into eBird, an opensource platform to record bird observation data. Each of the 183 sub cells had a complete checklist of 15 mins, submitted during the survey period Dec 2024 – Jan 2025. Each checklist contained information about the sub cell number, team number, name of observers, location and the habitat entered by the volunteers during the survey. The team of observers had a maximum of five people and a minimum of two, out of which at least one person was an expert at identifying the birds. All of the checklists were then submitted by sharing it with the Ahmedabad bird atlas team which were then verified to fit the protocol standards of the project.

Before the bird surveys began, several workshops and training sessions were organized in order to prepare the coordinators and the participants. Three types of sessions were held: interactive workshops (At Ahmedabad University Campus), online meetings and in-person field demonstrations. These sessions focused on the bird identification, survey protocols and demonstrations of applications like eBird and Google Earth. Several discussion meetings were held about ambiguous species, and ensuring accurate survey methods. These workshops and meetings helped participants become familiar with the concept of Bird Atlas surveys and the methods behind it.

## Analysis

After the eBird checklists were reviewed by the team, the data was then downloaded from eBird for analysis. For each species, the frequency of reporting was computed for each grid cell. Hence, for a grid cell, the frequency of reporting would be the proportion of observations in the cells. Since each grid cell has 3 sub cells that were sampled, the frequency of reporting could possibly be one of 4 values: not reported (0%), low (33%), medium (66%) and high (100%). For grid cells that were not completely surveyed, i.e. only one or two sub cells within a grid cell were sampled, the value was recorded as “Present” or “Absent”. “Present” represents grid cells that had the species recorded but not in all sub cells as the information is missing. Likewise, “Absent” represents grid cells that did not have the species recorded but it cannot be categorized as a true absence since there is missing information. All maps and frequency calculations were produced offline using R statistical software (version 4.4.1) with the *sf* package (Pebesma and Bivand, 2023) and *Tidyverse* package (Wickham et al., 2019).

Ambiguous species like “White egret sp.” Or “Cormorant sp.” were excluded from the analysis. For English and scientific names, Clements (2024) taxonomy was followed. Dietary information about the bird species was extracted from the *AVONET data base* (Tobias et al., 2022). Gujarati names were extracted from *A checklist of the birds of Gujarat - Version 2.0* (Ganpule, 2025).

## Key to use the Atlas




Figure 3. Representative figure of the species maps




Figure 4. Icons used to indicate habitat preference by bird species. Icons sourced from *Habitats of the world* (2021).

The species maps will contain both the picture of the species and the distribution map based on the atlas data (Fig 3). Figure 3 is a representative visualization, with the 3.3x3.3km grid cell of the Ahmedabad city and the filled squares of different intensity of purple represent the frequency of the species being observed. On the top left of the image there is a green bar chart that indicates the number of lists the species has been observed in. The top left of the image indicates which dietary group the species belongs to. The top right of the image shows the migratory status of the species: R for resident, M for migrant visitor, LM for local migrant visitor and PM for passover migrant visitor. The bottom right corner has icons of the habitat preference of the species (Fig 4).

## Results

A total of 181 species with the help of 141 eBird checklist, were recorded during the winter 2024 of Ahmedabad city Bird atlas survey. These account for 33% of the bird species found all over Gujarat. Out of the 181 species, 45 (25%) are migratory visitors, 11 (6%) are local migratory visitors, one is a passover migrant and the rest 124 (69%) species are resident birds. The most common were insectivorous species (40%) followed by aquatic predators (20%), omnivores (20%), granivores (8%), carnivores (6%), frugivores (3%) and herbivores (3%).

### Bird Richness




Figure 5. Map of the Ahmedabad City Bird Atlas showing the species richness in each grid cell. Dark coloured grid cells indicate higher richness than lightly coloured ones. The black outline indicates the boundary of Ahmedabad city.

Higher number of species were recorded in the outskirts of the cities (Fig 5). The interior of Ahmedabad city has a uniform richness of around 20-40 bird species which is lesser than the outer edges of the city. The outer edges have a less dense matrix of urban habitats and is interspersed with more open habitats and green spaces. Some areas remained unsampled and are represented as white squares.

Of the 181 species recorded during the survey, five of the most commonly documented birds include the Eurasian Collared-Dove, Common Myna, Rock Pigeon, Rose-ringed Parakeet and the Black Kite. These bird species have adapted to thrive in urban areas. Table 1 is a compilation of all the bird species seen, ordered from common to rare reported, along with information on their IUCN status and the Indian Wildlife protection act (IWPA) schedule. The results of the city-wide bird atlas shows that the more threatened species are rarely observed in the cities.
